

## You need:

- 3 feet of cash register tape
- markers; colored pencils
- creativity and imagination
- 1. Take your cash register tape and fold it in half so that it is approximately 18 inches long. Keep folding it in half until you have about a 2 inch square.
- 2. Unfold your cash register tape, and cross out two boxes on each end, leaving you with 12 boxes.



- 3. In each of the remaining squares, draw a picture that best represents you. It can be something you like such as
  - a. a sport
  - b. an animal
  - c. a type of food
  - d. a place
- 4. It can represent
  - a. your family
  - b. your beliefs
  - c. your nationality
  - d. what's important to you
- 5. Be prepared to share you individuality/symbol strip with the class.
