Rules and Examples

- A **declarative** sentence makes a statement. It ends with a period.
The movie starts in ten minutes.
- An **interrogative** sentence asks a question. It ends with a question mark.
Is Nancy coming with us?
- An **imperative** sentence makes a request or command. It ends with a period. The subject of an imperative sentence is always you understood.
Shut the door.
- An **exclamatory** sentence shows surprise or other strong feeling. It ends with an exclamation point.
Watch out for the car!
